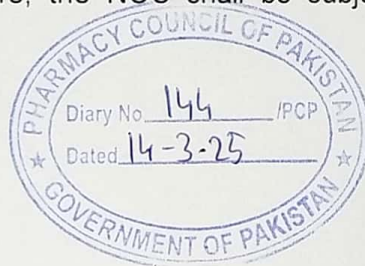



Please refer to the subject cited above.

2. This is to inform you that a panel comprising of members of Pharmacy Council of Pakistan, Islamabad, visited your institute on February 4, 2025 to assess the required facilities for the grant of NOC before the launch of Pharm. D Program.
3. The Council examined your report in its 62nd meeting held on March 01, 2025, and unanimously approved an annual intake of one hundred (100) students.

Terms & Conditions:

- i. The Institute can be inspected at any time with or without prior notice to evaluate the compliance status. Non-compliance may lead to withdrawal of NOC or any other penalty approved by the Council.
- ii. The Institute will ensure the "Enrolment of Students" within 60 days of admissions and the Institute/college/university will inform the Council regarding announcement of admissions with copies of relevant advertisement. Once enrolled, no deletion/ alteration in the enrollment of students is allowed.
- iii. The institute will admit the students once a year as per their approved allocation strength by the Council and will not exceed.
- iv. The recognition of the Pharm. D Program will be reserved only if all the conditions notified by the Pharmacy Council of Pakistan are adhered to.
- v. The Institute will immediately inform any change/modification in the physical facilities and in case of shifting the facility, the Institute will immediately inform and seek fresh approval for new premises.

- vi. The Institute will submit their "Clinical Pharmacy Training Program" along with the details and acceptance of such training program from the hospital.
- vii. It would be appreciated, if this Council is kept informed of the dates of the examination in pharmacy conducted by the degree awarding Institute, so that periodic assessment and evaluation of your examination system could be monitored through observers.
- viii. The Council has a legal right to revoke/withdraw the permission of admissions of Pharm. D Program if it observed any violation or non-compliance to the regulations/ directions/ instructions issued by the Council from time to time.
- ix. Compliance to any further conditions/guidelines issued by the PCP shall also be binding on the institute.
